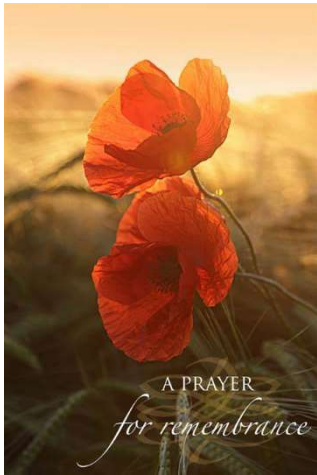

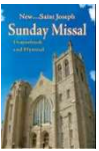


**Blessed are the Peacemakers**
