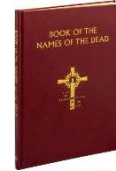

The *Book of the Names of the Dead* is now on the table beside Blessed Mary's statue at the front of the church for you to write the names of family/friends you would like prayers to be offered during November. This book will be placed on the altar at each Mass in November.



All Souls Day – November 2, 2025

You may request to have a candle burn in November for your deceased loved ones. The candles will be placed on the steps of the sanctuary in front of the pulpit and lit for each Mass in November. Candles may be purchased at the Gift Store for \$10.
