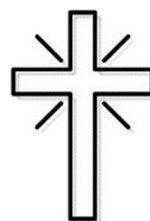

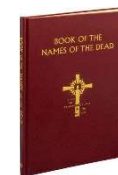
Papal Intention for November – For the Prevention of Suicide

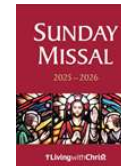
Mass Cards
